

RESOLUTION NO. 2004-02

**APPOINTING JUDGES FOR THE TOWN OF STRATTON'S
APRIL 6, 2004 ELECTION**

WHEREAS, the Town of Stratton, Colorado will hold its regular municipal election on Tuesday, April 6, 2004;

WHEREAS, the Colorado Revised Statutes § 31-10-401 require a minimum of three judges and such additional judges as deemed necessary;

WHEREAS, the Colorado Revised Statutes § 31-10-408 and § 1-6-115 allows for the compensation of election judges not less than five dollars (\$5); and

WHEREAS, the Town Clerk will contact persons who are willing to serve as judges and alternate judge at the April 6, 2004 election.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Council of Stratton, Colorado gives the Town Clerk the authority and responsibility to appoint persons to serve as election judges and head judge at the April 6, 2004 election.

These judges will receive \$65.00 compensation each for the day; also lunch and dinner will be provided by the Town.

In the event any of the judges cannot assume their position as judge on April 6, 2004, the alternate judge will be notified by the Town Clerk to fill the vacant position.

In the event any two judges (including alternate) cannot assume their position as judge on April 6, 2004, the Town Council of Stratton grants the Town Clerk the authority and responsibility to appoint the replacement judges for the election.


