Resolution No. 2004-03

**Adopting the Northeast Colorado Emergency Managers (NCEM)
Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan**

Whereas, Town of Stratton recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within our community; and

Whereas, undertaking hazard mitigation actions will reduce the potential for harm to people and property from future hazard occurrences; and

Whereas, an adopted Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan is required as a condition of future funding for mitigation projects under multiple FEMA pre- and post-disaster mitigation grant programs; and

Whereas, Town of Stratton resides within the I I -county NCEM Planning Area, and fully participated in the NCEM mitigation planning process to prepare this Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

Whereas, the Colorado Office of Emergency Management and Federal Emergency Management Agency, Region VIII officials have reviewed the NCEM Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan and approved it contingent upon this official adoption of the participating governments and entities;

Now, therefore, be it resolved, that the Town of Stratton, hereby adopts the NCEM Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan as an official plan; and


