

RESOLUTION NO. 2012-2

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF STRATTON, COLORADO DECLARING CANDIDATES ELECTED AND PROVIDING FOR THE CANCELATION OF THE REGULAR ELECTION

WHEREAS, pursuant to §31-10-507, C.R.S., the Board of Trustees is permitted to instruct the Clerk to cancel the election if at the close of business on the nineteenth day before the election, there are not more candidates than offices to be filled at such election.

WHEREAS, on February 14, 1994, the Board of Trustees adopted Ordinance No. 69-A, which provides for write-in candidates for elections and the cancellation of elections if there are not more candidates than offices to be filled at such election, pursuant to §31-10-507, C.R.S.;

WHEREAS, an election is set for April 3, 2012 to elect 5 Trustees and the Mayor; and

WHEREAS, there are only 5 qualified applicants for the Trustee vacancies and 1 applicant for the Mayor vacancy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Stratton, Colorado:

Section 1. Candidates for Office. The following qualified candidates for Trustee are Chris English (4 year), Doyle Loutzenhiser (4 year), Jeff Shean (4 year), J. Phillip Rogers (2 year) and William (Butch) Davis (2 year); and the following qualified candidate for Mayor is Richard Mann (4 year).

Section 2. Candidates for Office Declared Elected. The following candidates for Trustee are hereby declared elected: Chris English (4 year), Doyle Loutzenhiser (4 year), Jeff Shean (4 year), J. Phillip Rogers (2 year) and William (Butch) Davis (2 year); and the following qualified candidate for Mayor is hereby declared elected: Richard Mann (4 year).


Section 3. Cancellation of Election. The Board of Trustees hereby cancels the election set for April 3, 2012.

Section 4. Publication of Notice of Cancellation. Notice of the Cancellation of Election, and/or a copy of this resolution, shall be published immediately.

Section 5. Posting of Notice of Cancellation. Notice of Cancellation of Election, and/or a copy of this Resolution, shall be posted at each polling place and in not less than one other public place.

Section 6. Immediate Effect. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
