A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A PARKING AGREEMENT WITH MINERAL COUNTY

WHEREAS, the City has the legal authority to enter into agreements to develop and improve parking within the City of Creede; and

WHEREAS, Mineral County is desirous of improving the public parking area across from the Mineral County Health Clinic and Mineral County Road & Bridge yard; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees finds this resolution will thereby promote the health, safety and general welfare of the Creede community.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CITY OF CREEDE, THAT;

SECTION 1: The above and foregoing recitals are incorporated herein by reference and adopted as findings and determinations of the Board of Trustees.

SECTION 2: The Board of Trustees hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute the Parking Agreement with Mineral County, attached as **Exhibit A**.



**PARKING AGREEMENT
BETWEEN CITY OF CREEDE AND MINERAL COUNTY**

Mineral County agrees to provide on City property an improved public parking area across from the Health Clinic and the County Road & Bridge yard. The County will install necessary culverts, fill material, and provide grading to create a public parking area. The County will keep the area maintained for parking but will not landscape for aesthetic purposes, nor build any structure that is not for parking purposes.


This area will cover a width from Rio Grande Avenue on the east to the slope of the hill on the west and the approximate length is between the westerly extension of the south boundary line of Block 24 and the westerly extension of the north boundary line of Block 33 in South Creede.


This agreement can be terminated by either party upon thirty (30) days written notice. However, as long as the area remains a public parking area, the County can use it for parking purposes.


This constitutes the full agreement approved by the Board of Trustees at their regularly scheduled meeting on November, 6, 2012.
