

## RESOLUTION NO. 2014 - 03

### A RESOLUTION REPEALING RESOLUTION 2013-14 AUTHORIZING THE CONDUCT OF A MAIL BALLOT ELECTION FOR THE CITY OF CREEDE'S REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION SCHEDULED FOR APRIL 1, 2014

WHEREAS, Resolution 2013-14 was approved and passed December 3, 2013 for the specific purpose of authorizing the conduct of a mail ballot election for the City of Creede's regular municipal election scheduled April 1, 2014; and

WHEREAS, legislative changes affecting municipal mail ballot elections have been enacted by HB-1303; and

WHEREAS, those changes have the potential to increase costs and complications for municipal mail ballot elections; and


WHEREAS, corrective legislation is forthcoming but adoption dates and implementation procedures are not yet known; and

WHEREAS, the Board no longer finds it to be in the best interest of the citizens of Creede, Colorado that the municipal election scheduled for April 1, 2014 be conducted by mail ballot election; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of City of Creede, A Colorado Town that Resolution 2013-14 is repealed and is no longer in effect, and the municipal election set for April 1, 2014 shall be conducted by polling place.
