RESOLUTION NO. 2014-04**

A RESOLUTION DECLARING POLICIES FOR ATV/OHV PRIVATE EVENTS

WHEREAS, the City of Creede recognizes the ability for tourists and locals alike to pursue recreation opportunities; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Creede does not support complete ATV/OHV access throughout all Municipal streets and alleys; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Creede understands the need for compromise on the ATV/OHV issue while keeping with its stated vision of “balancing planning and freedom in order to maintain, and continue the authentic, historic community that is Creede;” and,

WHEREAS, the City of Creede currently utilizes a “Private Event Permit” process; and,

WHEREAS, City of Creede would like to encourage the formation, or continuation, of a group to partner with in promoting ATV/OHV events throughout the tourist season in order to provide opportunities to complete the “Bachelor Loop” Tour at designated times.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CITY OF CREEDE, a Colorado Town that:

SECTION 1. ATV/OHV use may be permitted on City streets with approval by and through the Private Event Permit process in accordance with such conditions, requirements and limitations as may be determined by the Board of Trustees.

SECTION 2. The Board of Trustees may appoint one or more representatives to serve as a liaison to or as a board or committee member of, a group formed to promote ATV/OHV events that serve the Creede community.
