All roads should intersect at right angles. An 18-inch diameter corrugated metal pipe culvert will be required by the County unless otherwise determined. The culvert must extend past the private access road's turning "Flare" by at least 18 inches on each end. **On the reverse of this application draw a detailed sketch of the intersection showing:** The lot and #, location of driveway, and distance to a lot-line. **Mark the proposed access with two flagged lathes (description & ownership on lathes) for inspection and approval by County.** (Note: A 12 ft. road requires a 20' culvert; 14 ft. road a 22' culvert).



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The issuance of this permit does not create legal access to the County Road and does not suggest that the Applicant has any legal access whatsoever. This permit only establishes the Applicant's right to enter the County Road at a given point. Legal Access to that point is the sole responsibility of the Applicant. There is a \$75.00 dollar fee for this application.
