
City Staff

Project Team



Responsibilities include solicitation of public input, technical analysis and design of the project. The City of Idaho Springs will select a consultant for formal construction documents as well as a contractor for construction of Phase III.



Phase III Steering Committee

A steering committee has been formed for Phase III of the project and is helping in project development as shown below:

- **What?** A Steering Committee is a group that decides on goals and priorities of a project.
- **Who?** The Steering Committee is a combination of business owners and residents living in the project area.
- **How?** The Steering Committee acts on behalf of the larger community to provide input for consideration based on their local knowledge and expertise. In doing so, the Steering Committee helps create a comprehensive project that best meets current and future needs of the community. Steering Committee members will reach out to community members to ensure a variety of stakeholders' concerns are heard.
- **When?** The Steering Committee meets on an as needed basis to review information and make recommendations to City Council and the Project Team. To date, the Steering Committee has met five times.
