Notice is given of a public hearing to afford all interested persons an opportunity to be heard prior to the adoption of proposed amendments to the Workers' Compensation Rules of Procedure, 7 C.C.R. 1101-3 as described below. The Director of the Division of Workers' Compensation has the authority to promulgate rules pursuant to the Workers' Compensation Act as set forth in section 8-47-107 as well as sections 8-44-112 and 8-46-102, C.R.S.

The public hearing will be held in accordance with the provisions of the Colorado Administrative Procedures Act, section 24-4-103, CRS. Any interested party is invited to appear at the hearing and testify or to submit written data, arguments or position papers to Paul Tauriello, Director, Division of Workers' Compensation, 633 17<sup>th</sup> Street, Suite 400, Denver, CO 80202. Any written submissions should be submitted to the Director prior to the hearing on July 18, 2016.

The topic to be considered is:

The proposed rule changes effect rules 1, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9. The proposal corrects grammar, spelling and formatting errors as well as rewriting some sections for clarity. The proposed rule will also address documents required to be attached to final admissions, scheduling for prehearing conferences and choice of advisement procedures for settlements. Finally, the proposal introduces new language to reflect changes to statute in rules 8 (change of physician) and 5 (safety rule violations).

The proposed rule changes will be available at the Department's website on or before June 16, 2016. Copies of the proposed rules will also be available by request on June 16, 2016 at the Division's Customer Service Office, 633 17<sup>th</sup> Street, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor, Denver, Colorado.
