## Helping Colorado be a Place Where Everyone Can Maintain a Healthy, Mobile and Vibrant Life as They Age

**Colorado's older adult population is one of the fastest-growing nationwide.** Older adults are vital to Colorado. Their lifetimes of experience, knowledge and wisdom improve our state and its urban, rural and tribal communities.

**This incredible growth represents opportunities and challenges** as we strive to enhance and protect the quality of life for all Coloradans.

The General Assembly created **the Strategic Action Planning Group on Aging (SAPGA)** to produce a comprehensive plan to prepare our state for the wide-ranging effects of this permanent demographic shift. Governor John Hickenlooper appointed 23 members with diverse backgrounds from throughout Colorado to study the effects of the state's growing aging population through 2030.

SAPGA committees address specific topics foundational to the plan and offer recommendations to state policymakers. Committees include:

- Physical community
- Workforce development
- Health and wellness
- Supportive community
- Family economic security
- Outreach and communication
- Public finance

SAPGA will produce the plan by Nov. 30, 2016, with updates scheduled for 2018 and 2020.
