All others have paper based data entry with Xeroxed copies.</li> <li>• CMS certification (e.g., MITA) required for vendors?             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◦ Parrish said that the system has to meet seven standards of MITA and will be interested in learning what vendors can help meet this.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Could add a housing registry as part of the I&amp;R database.</li> <li>• Want to ensure that this effort is a part of the interchange program.</li> <li>• What currently exists in the requirements for the interchange, and if they can be matched from the HCBS Strategies IT draft and if they don't match up then a change request may be in order. There are some optional criteria and requirements from HPs proposal.
