ORDINANCE NO. 492

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2 OF TITLE 3 OF THE WINTER PARK TOWN CODE TO LEVY AN ADDITIONAL 2% SALES TAX FOR TRANSIT PURPOSES, AS APPROVED BY THE TOWN'S VOTERS ON NOVEMBER 3, 2015

WHEREAS, Section 3-2-3(B) of Chapter 2, Title 3 of the Winter Park Town Code levies a sales tax of 5% of the gross receipts on sales of tangible personal property at retail and the furnishing of services, with the exception of the tax on sales of rooms or accommodations, which is 4%;

WHEREAS, on November 3, 2015, the Town's voters approved a 2% increase in the existing Town sales tax for the purpose of the acquisition, construction, operation, and maintenance of public transit, public multi-modal transportation improvements, and public trails within and near the Town, with such tax to be effective on December 1, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council wishes to amend the Winter Park Town Code to levy the additional 2% transit sales tax.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Winter Park, Colorado:

Section 1. Section 3-2-3 of the Winter Park Town Code is hereby amended by the addition of the following new subsection D:

D. Transit Sales Tax: In addition to the taxes set forth in Subsections B and C hereof, there is hereby imposed on all sales of tangible personal property at retail and the furnishing of services, a tax equal to two percent (2%) of the gross receipts. Expenditures of the revenue received from the two percent (2%) transit sales tax shall be used only for the acquisition, construction, operation, and maintenance of public transit, public multi-modal transportation improvements, and public trails within and near the Town.
