

# Statewide Data Analytics Contractor (SDAC)

## What is the purpose of a statewide data analytics contractor (SDAC)?

The SDAC is responsible for providing secure electronic access to clinically actionable data to the Regional Care Collaborative Organizations ([RCCOs](#)) and Primary Care Medical Providers ([PCMPs](#)) to help them meet the goals of the Accountable Care Collaborative ([ACC](#)) – to improve client health and reduce costs.

## How does the SDAC help RCCOs and PCMPs?

- Allows PCMPs to better coordinate Medicaid clients' care by providing secure access to diagnoses, prescriptions, and other health information;
- Provides reports to PCMPs and RCCOs to help eliminate avoidable and duplicative procedures; and
- Analyzes claims to identify potentially preventable health events (e.g. ER visits, hospital readmissions).

## What data will be stored in the SDAC data repository?

### Today:

- Medicaid paid claims data (including ICD-10 diagnoses and PCS codes) for the Medicaid population;
- Clinical risk group (CRG) identifiers and predictive risk scores; and
- Behavioral Health Organization managed care encounter data.

### Proposed for the Future:

- Clinical data from RCCOs and/or PCMPs (e.g., member care coordination, referrals to non-medical services, and medical management activities);
- Disease and immunization registries (e.g. Colorado Immunization Information System) data;
- National health survey data (e.g. PRAMS, BRFSS); and
- Colorado Regional Health Information Organization (CORHIO) electronic health records data.

## What reports will be available?

- Profiles of individual clients based upon predictive modeling;
- Identification of areas for clinical process improvement at the client, provider and RCCO levels; and
- Aggregate reporting of cost and utilization performance indicators.

## Who can access this information?

You must be a RCCO or PCMP in the Accountable Care Collaborative to access the SDAC information. Information is secure and only available for the patients these entities are responsible for.
