The Construction Stormwater General Permit

- Tool for minimizing pollutants in stormwater from construction sites
- Same umbrella requirements for all covered projects
- **Certification** authorizes your site
- Quicker turnaround times (10 days vs. 180 days)



Renewal of the General Permit

- 5 year permit term
- Opportunity to update and include:
 - Clarified language
 - Applicable guidance
 - New ideas



General Permit Renewal: Considerations

- House bill 12-1119:
 - We will continue to discuss the following option:
 - Explore how compliance might be improved if permits were tied to ownership.

General Permit Renewal: Considerations

- Review
 - Stormwater inspections conducted at construction sites.
 - Other states - most recent construction stormwater general permits.
 - EPA most recent Construction General Permit and Effluent Limitations Guidelines.

General Permit: Proposed Changes

- Change permit number:
 - From COR030000 to COR400000.
- Adjust layout of permit.
- Clarify requirements.

General Permit: Proposed Changes

- Remove obsolete/duplicative requirements.
- Incorporate effluent limitation guidelines.
- Add minimum training requirement.

General Permit: Proposed Changes

Owner/Operator Requirements

- Background -
 - Issue has and continues to come up in the compliance process
 - Extensive discussion of the issue in the HB12-1119 Stakeholder process
 - Division committed to discuss the issue during permit renewal
 - Other states have now addressed the issue

General Permit: Proposed Changes

Owner/Operator Requirements

- Draft options-
 - Make no changes.
 - Require co-permittees
 - Require signatures on application from both the owner and the operator
 - Require signatures from just the operator, and notify the owner of permit coverage

General Permit: Proposed Changes

Owner/Operator Requirements *(cont.)*

- Draft Options:
 - The operator must provide owner information but would not be required to be a permittee.
- Separate permit for owner
 - Owner would hold a separate permit.
