DEFINITIONS:

C/I Classroom/Instructional Training

OJT On the Job Training

Disc. Discretionary Training as determined by the Qualified Supervisor. this training will be **C/I** and/or **OJT** as determined by the Qualified Supervisor.

TECHNICIANS:

Applicator Technician: No experience - applies pesticides.

Sales Technician: Sells pesticide applications - does not apply pesticides.

Experienced Technician: A technician who has been trained and has one season of experience including time in training within the last three years.

On going technician: (Applicator/Sales Technician) a technician continuing to work for the same entity after their first season of experience.

TRAINING TOPICS:

Applicator Technician:

C/I Applicable State, Federal and local laws and regulations, environmental\ precautions, use, equipment and calibration, pesticides and their families, pest management, applicator safety, pesticide label and labeling, host and pest identification, and public safety.

OJT Environmental precautions, use, equipment and calibration, pesticides and their families, applicator safety, pesticide label and labeling, host and pest identification, and public safety. **60 hours of this training shall be conducted by a licensed QS or a licensed CO has at least 1 year of structural pesticide application experience WITHIN the last 2 years**

Disc. Divided between **C/I** and **OJT** as the need is determined by the qualified supervisor.

NOTE: In addition to the above training topics each applicator technician shall have **the minimum on-going training:** 2 hours per month of training over a 6 month period include at least 3 hours of **C/I** training. 9 hours shall be divided between **C/I** and **OJT** as determined by the qualified supervisor. Each technician shall also successfully complete a written examination prepared and given by the commercial applicator showing overall comprehension of the subject matter of all the training.

Sales Technician:

C/I Applicable State, Federal and local laws and regulations, environmental precautions, use, equipment and calibration, pesticides and their families, pest management, applicator safety, pesticide label and labeling, host and pest identification, and public safety.

OJT Environmental precautions, use, equipment and calibration, pesticides and their families, applicator safety, pesticide label and labeling, host and pest identification, and public safety. **60 hours of this training shall be conducted by a licensed QS or a licensed CO has at least 1 year of structural pesticide application experience WITHIN the last 2 years**

Disc. Divided between **C/I** and **OJT** as the need is determined by the qualified supervisor.

NOTE: In addition to the above training topics each applicator technician shall have **the minimum on-going training:** 2 hours per month of training over a 6 month period include at least 3 hours of **C/I** training. 9 hours shall be divided between **C/I** and **OJT** as determined by the qualified supervisor. Experienced Technician:

C/I Applicable State, Federal and local laws and regulations, environmental precautions, use, equipment and calibration, pesticides and their families, pest management, applicator safety, pesticide label and labeling, host and pest identification, and public safety.

OJT Environmental precautions, use, equipment and calibration, Pesticides and their families, applicator safety, pesticide label and labeling, host and pest identification, and public safety. **16 hours of this training shall be conducted by a licensed QS or a licensed CO has at least 1 year of structural pesticide application experience WITHIN the last 2 years**

Disc. Divided between **C/I** and **OJT** as the need is determined by the qualified supervisor.
