



Dear Provider,

The Department of Health Care Policy & Financing (the Department) is working to resolve issues impacting Substance Use Disorder (SUD) provider enrollment in the Colorado interChange.

Department policy allows only one enrollment per provider in the Colorado interChange. However, some SUD providers are currently enrolled as both an SUD Individual Provider (provider type 63) and a Master's Level Psychologist (provider type 38). Please note that **providers can only have one enrollment associated with their social security number (SSN)**, even if they are providing services at multiple locations. This applies to an individual within a group (IWG); an ordering, prescribing or referring (OPR) provider; or a billing individual.

Moving forward, the Department will no longer accept new enrollments under provider type 63. DXC Technology (DXC) is updating the Colorado interChange to ensure provider type 38 can bill for the same services as provider type 63.

Providers with active enrollments as both provider type 63 **and** provider type 38 may voluntarily disenroll the provider type 63 enrollment via the [Provider Web Portal](#) if they have not already been disenrolled by DXC.

All SUD providers enrolling with Health First Colorado (Colorado's Medicaid Program) and/or Child Health Plan *Plus* (CHP+) should apply as provider type 38.
