


ICD-10 PROVIDER READINESS SURVEY HIGHLIGHTS

WHY IS ICD-10 IMPORTANT?

ICD-10 codes will be replacing the ICD-9 code sets currently used to report medical diagnoses and inpatient procedures **effective October 1, 2014**. The Department of Health Care Policy and Financing released a Provider Readiness Survey in late 2013 to gauge the Medicaid provider community's preparedness for this transition. Below are some survey highlights, as well as additional resources for ICD-10 implementation.

PROVIDERS BY TYPE



44% of provider community uses a **Billing Vendor**

60% of provider community is taking **active steps towards ICD-10 implementation**

32% are planning

10% are programming

13% are testing

40% of providers stated they **may not be ready for implementation by October 1st!**
