Job Summary:

We operate a multi-sport program that includes tubing, rafting, kayaking, hiking, biking and off highway vehicles (OHV). While employees may specialize in one sport, they will be expected to support and cross-train in other disciplines.

Team members will instruct, assist in river launches, retrievals, shuttles, and transportation to and from river egress sites and mountain trailheads. Responsibilities will include maintaining and cleaning equipment, rental of equipment, instructing customers, customer services and coordinating logistics.
