Notes:

- 1 The status of the claim is based on documents which have been filed with the Division of Workers' Compensation as of January 22, 2013. An "Admission" is a claim for which a document with some indicator of liability has been filed, including a Fatal Admission or Final Pay Notice. A "Denial" claim is one for which a "Notice of Contest" has been filed, advising that the payer has not accepted liability for the injury or disease.
- 2 "Admission" counts also include those claims first denied then later admitted.
- 3 This information is taken from death certificates and admission/denial files; five (5) cases had no death certificate.
- 4 There are five (5) "Indeterminate" fatal claims not included in the totals count.
