The Victim Services Division (VSD) links families affected by the loss or disappearance of a loved one with service providers, support networks, and other resources to help them navigate the complex and difficult environment in which they find themselves.

By bringing people, information, forensic science, and technology together, NamUs helps resolve missing, unidentified, and unclaimed person cases nationwide, while providing support to the victims and their families.

Services Provided

Peer Support Program

- Recruit and train a team of volunteer peer providers
- Connect individuals to a peer provider with experiential knowledge

Reunification

- VSD will screen and identify eligible cases to assist in returning deceased loved ones home
- The process may include exhumation, cremation, or re-interment based on the families' wishes, cultures, traditions and beliefs.

Mental Health

- Connect individuals to available support groups
- Provide resources and referrals to those in need of mental health treatment to include referrals to:
 - Trauma-informed therapies
 - Crisis counseling
