Vonda Hall represented state employees in private practice until 2011, and also served as Staff Attorney and General Counsel for the Colorado Association of Public Employees (CAPE) for 15 years. She holds a Bachelor of Arts and Master of Education degree from the State University of New York at Buffalo and a Juris Doctor degree from the University of Cincinnati College of Law where she was a Fellow of the Urban Morgan Institute of Human Rights.

Vonda successfully litigated pivotal cases for state employees, including Colorado Association of Public Employees v. Department of Highways, which placed restrictions on contracting-out, and Department of Institutions v. Kinchen, which held that the agency has the burden of proving just cause for disciplining state classified employees.

Vonda was first elected to the State Personnel Board in September 2013 and was certified for a second term in June 2016 after being nominated in an uncontested state wide election. Her term is July 1, 2016 to June 30, 2019.
