Toilet Flushing

- Concerns about antibiotic resistant bacteria like C. Dif.
- Reclaimed water treaters continue their support.
- Other states' requirements will be evaluated.

Edible Crops

- Treaters continue to support.
- One area of focus is adequate management of risk posed by pathogens.
- Currently looking at practices in other states.

Total Dissolved Solids- Vegetation

- Concerns about effects on *vegetation and soils*.
- Best management practices are very site specific.
- TDS treatment requirements would prevent use of reclaimed water.
- Evaluating appropriateness of other types of requirements in Regulation 84.

Total Dissolved Solids-Groundwater

- Concerns about effects on *groundwater*.
- Discharges from irrigation with reclaimed water specifically exempt from permitting in Regulation 61.
- Effects on groundwater from reclaimed water is not ripe for Regulation 84.



- Notice (WQCC and Colorado Register)
- Party status
- Proponents prehearing statements
- Responsive prehearing statements
- Rebuttal statements
- Prehearing conference
- Rulemaking hearing

- April 13, 2016: WQCD will submit memo to WQCC and stakeholders.
- April 27, 2016: Stakeholder comments due to WQCC.
