## **FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT**

TO ALL INTERESTED GOVERNMENTAL AGENCIES AND PUBLIC GROUPS:

As required by guidelines for the preparation of environmental impact statements, an environmental review has been performed on the proposed action below:

Project: Town of Larkspur

Location: Douglas County, Colorado

Project No.: 960061D

Total Cost: \$3,300,000

### **Project Description**

The proposed project consists of drilling a new well, constructing a new water storage tank, expanding a pump station, and replacing the existing pump, iron and manganese removal system, and pressure reducing valve.

The project will be funded in part by a Drinking Water State Revolving Fund loan in the amount of \$2,000,000 at an interest rate of 0%, and a principal forgiveness loan in the amount of \$847,920. The project will increase the user rates by \$38.58 per month.

This Finding of No Significant Impact (FNSI) is to reaffirm an existing FNSI issued by the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) Rural Development dated April 22, 2013 and published on August 15, 2013 in the Douglas County News-Press for public comment. The initial action did not indicate that significant environmental impacts would result from the proposed action and so a preliminary decision not to prepare an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) was made. This action is taken on the basis of a careful review of the engineering report, environmental assessment, and other supporting data on file in the Water Quality Control Division of the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, and is available for public review upon request. This action does not require a public comment period as it reaffirms a previous action.

This action is effective upon publication.
