


Perfluorinated compounds (PFCs): latest observation in source water

Environmental water samples were collected from groundwater or surface water. If your water comes from a public water system, environmental water is not what comes out of your tap. Green dots are groundwater samples and purple dots are surface water samples. The number on the sample is an identifier.

PFC Groundwater Wells (Latest Observation)

Sum PFOS + PFOA + PFHpA (parts per trillion / ppt)

- Not Detected
- 1.8 to 66 ppt
- 73.5 to 100 ppt
- 101 to 408 ppt
- 480 to 690 ppt
- 2000 ppt

PFC Surface Samples (Latest Observation)

Sum PFOS + PFOA + PFHpA (parts per trillion / ppt)

- 4.2 to 47.5 ppt
- 490 to 791 ppt
