2015 Suggestions for Watershed Projects and Watershed Plans

I. Suggestions for Upper and Lower Colorado River Watershed Projects

Snake River and Peru Creek – COUCBL06 ad 07

- Watershed plan and completed Total Maximum Daily Loads.
- Significant restoration work is on-going.
- Address current priorities and timing and capacity issues.

Illinois Gulch – COUCBL12

- Completed Total Maximum Daily Loads but no watershed plan.
- Significant assessment/characterization work has been done.
- Requires a draft watershed plan to identify needs and priorities.

North Platte – COUCNP07b and 09

- Recently completed watershed plan.
- Initial implementation of restoration priorities.

Tributaries to Colorado River, Roaring Fork to Parachute - COLCLC04a

- Water quality analysis for pending watershed plan completed. TMDL in preliminary stages.
- Initial implementation of restoration priorities.

II. Suggestions for Watershed Plans / Assessments - Limited funding available

Elk River – COUCYA08

- Contribute to Upper Yampa watershed plan development and implementation.
- *Escherichia coli* data collection and assessment.
- Description of restoration needs to bring segment into attainment of water quality standards.

Clear Creek Watershed Comprehensive Assessment – COSPCL02, 03a, 03b, 06, 09a, 09b, 11, 13b

- Older watershed plan documents and completed TMDLs.
- History of remediation activities.
- Assess status of water quality and progress toward meeting standards for heavy metals. New water quality sampling is eligible.
- Identify key additional restoration priorities.
- Contribute to watershed plan update.
