Cold and Flu Season is Here!

It is best to only use organic raw honey that is unpasteurized and it is also beneficial to use Ceylon cinnamon compared to cassia cinnamon, as it more nutrient dense.

Ingredients:

1/4 teaspoon cinnamon

1 teaspoon raw honey



Mix honey and cinnamon.

Take it 2 times a day, for 3 days as soon as you feel a cold or flu coming on.

Another easy way to take the mixture is to spread it on a slice of bread.
