**Critical Incident:**

The call came in as a female who locked herself in the bathroom with her son and her husband was outside the bathroom with a gun. The officer noticed a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage on the defendant's breath. The officer asked him if he had been drinking. The defendant said he had three shots and a couple "dabs" (marijuana concentrate). His eyes were bloodshot and he seemed to be confused at times.

The officer could smell growing marijuana in the house. The officers were in the living room and noticed a red tarp that went from the ceiling to the floor. The officers asked him if there was a marijuana grow room in the house. The defendant said there was. He went to the red tarp and opened it using a zipper that was on the corner. Inside officers I noticed four marijuana plants that contained buds.

The officers advised him the grow room needed to be in a room with a lock on it so his son didn't have access to it. The officers noticed two butane torches, a cap with a filter, marijuana residue in a prescription bottle, and several other items that are used to make hash on the kitchen table. It appeared to me that they had made the marijuana concentrate that they had smoked.

Both the male and female had scratch and bite marks and both were arrested for Domestic Violence. A friend was called and took the child while the parents were in jail.

### **Critical Incident:**

On February 1, 2015 at about 1658 hours an Officer responded to a domestic violence that happened earlier in the day. The victim told the Officer that her boyfriend, had been arrested and plead guilty to a domestic that occurred in December of 2014. She was the victim. The Defendant is now on probation for that domestic. The victim said he has been coming over to the house for the last month. She said she didn't say anything because of the children. She showed me bruising on her right hip, left forearm, and back that was healing and yellow in color. She told me that the Defendant had done that to her.

The Defendant came to her house today, February 1, 2015, between 0700 and 0800 hours wanting to take the car because he had to go to Denver or someplace. She gave him the keys. She said she had discovered a hidden app on her cell phone that the Defendant had put there. This app forwards her text messages, email, and her location to his phone. He grabbed her phone from her and slapped her face. She said she ran into the bathroom and tried to get out the bathroom to get away from him. He grabbed her by the hair and threw her on the floor.

The Defendant was located and arrested.

On 02-02-15 at approximately 1300 hours the police department was advised that a rifle was stolen from a residence. After investigation the rifle was located and the above Defendant was served a citation while he was in jail for theft and burglary for that stolen rifle.

On 02-02-15 the Defendant was in Court and advised to not have any contact with the victim or the children. The Defendant made three calls from the jail to a friend to call the victim and the children. On February 8, 2015 an Officer issued a summons for Violation of a Protection Order. The Defendant was in the Lake County Jail when served.

### **Critical Incidents:**

On March 17, 2015 at about 0447 hours dispatch received a 911 call saying a 39 year female was unresponsive. When officers arrived CPR was being administered by the reporting party. Medical personnel arrived shortly thereafter and continued resuscitation efforts. Medical personnel said they were going to do two more rounds of EPI and then contact the doctor and get permission to discontinue resuscitation. After two more rounds of EPI they contacted the medical advisor in Summit County and advised the doctor of the situation. They received the order to discontinue resuscitation and the doctor pronounced her dead a 0520 hours.

Results from the autopsy show there was no foul play involved but the coroner is awaiting results from toxicology tests to determine the exact cause of death.

On March 6, 2015 a female came to the police department to make a report about two handwritten notes that had been left on her car. She thought she knew who wrote the notes. The suspect lives in her neighborhood and acts strangely when she is around. After a handwriting analysis was performed it was determined that this gentlemen was the author of these notes. The gentleman was arrested on harassment charges and is awaiting his court date.

On May 1, 2015 there were three Leadville Police Officers added to the memorial wall at Camp George West in Golden, Colorado. To my knowledge all "Fallen Leadville Police Officers" are now on the Fallen Officers Wall.

The complete roster of Leadville Police Officer on the Memorial Wall is as follows:

- Marshall George O'Connor April 1878 Gunfire
- Officer Thomas Tolbert July 1879 Gunfire
- Sergeant Lauristan Stewart 1880 Gunfire
- Officer John Carville 1880 gunfire
- Officer Samuel Townsend March 1882 Gunfire
- Officer Chris Fahey 1934 Auto Accident
- Officer Alvin Nelson 1949 Gunfire

In February I was contacted by the Fallen Officers committee and learned three of Leadville's Finest were not on the Fallen Officers Wall. The main criteria for being on the wall is an officer must have lost his life in the line of duty.
