# NOTICE OF SALES AND USE TAX RATE INCREASE

Dear Taxpayer:

On November 6, 2018, Central City voters approved a two percent (2%) increase in the City's sales and use tax rate to provide funding for City of Central fire protection and public safety services, programs and facilities, with the tax increase to be effective January 1, 2019.

The new Central City sales and use tax rate will be six percent (6%) for all transactions occurring on or after January 1, 2019.

This notification has been sent as a courtesy reminder to all licensed retailers within the City. The City of Central is a self-collecting sales tax entity and the City's Finance Department administers the collection of all City sales and use taxes.
