

NOTICE OF INTENT TO CONSIDER THE IMPOSITION OF  
AVAILABILITY OF SERVICE OR FACILITIES CHARGES

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, pursuant to § 32-1-1006(1)(h), C.R.S., and § 32-1-1001(2)(a), C.R.S., the Board of Directors for the Cascade Metropolitan District No. 1 (the “District”) will consider the imposition of availability of service or facilities charges (the “AOS charge”) at a public meeting to be held on **Tuesday, August 23, 2016, at 5:30 P.M.**, at the Cascade Fire Station, 8015 Severy Road Cascade, Cascade, Colorado 80809. Any interested taxpaying elector of the District may attend the public meeting.

NOTICE IS FURTHER PROVIDED that, pursuant to §32-1-1006(1)(h), C.R.S., the AOS charge may only be assessed where water lines are installed and ready for connection, but not yet connected, within one hundred feet (100’) of any property line of the residential lot or residential lot equivalent to be assessed. The AOS charge shall not exceed fifty percent (50%) of the fees, rates, tolls or charges for use of services or facilities of the District and shall solely be used for the purpose of paying principal of and interest on any outstanding indebtedness or bonds of the District.

**IT IS FURTHER PROVIDED that properties currently receiving water service from the District shall not be subject to the AOS charge.**
