School Bus Safety :

Yellow flashing lights indicate that the bus is preparing to stop to pickup or drop off children. Drivers need to slow down and prepare to stop. Red flashing lights and an extended stop arm signal indicate that the bus is stopped, and that children are getting on or off. Cars must stop a safe distance away and not proceed until the red lights stop flashing, the stop sign folds back, and the bus continues on its way.

Watch your speed limit in flashing school zones!

Starting Monday, August 3rd, the Town of Ignacio is working to bring some of our gas lines up to state and federal standards. For the next eight weeks you will see crews out working to replace 1400 feet of pipe totaling a distance of 1/4 mile starting at Ignacio street and working south. During this time there will be some minor traffic re-routing inconveniences. We ask for your patience as we work to complete this project in a timely manner. Gas Message

If you smell natural gas in your home or business please leave immediately!

Leave light switches alone especially in the area you smell gas. **WAIT to use your cell phone until you can no longer smell any gas.** Call 911, the Fire Department at 563-9501, or Dispatch at 563-4401 if you smell gas at any time.

Burn Pile Rules



Please remember when you take items to the burn pile, they have to be wood, trees, or brush. We do not allow Furniture, TV's, Tar Paper, or Chemicals except during fall and spring clean-up. During inclement weather we will not unlock the gates as it is too muddy to access in rain or snow.
