Approved Identity Verification Documents

The Office of the State Registrar of Vital Statistics requires the following documentation:

At least 1 of the following: All documents presented must be current and valid. Expired documents drop to the Secondary Listing. Documents that do not contain either an issue or an expiration date will not be considered acceptable.	Or at least 2 of the following: (Any document expired more than six months will not be accepted).

Novelty ID Card
Non-expiring Identification Cards
City or County detention center ID cards
Souvenir birth certificates (hospital issued)

If you cannot provide acceptable identification, it is suggested that you ask a spouse, parent, grandparent, sibling, or adult child, who can provide appropriate identification and prove relationship, to request the certificate for you. **Proof of relationship is required**, such as a birth certificate or marriage certificate.
