Come now the undersigned petitioners, and under and by virtue of the provisions of Sections 6513 et seq. of the revised Statutes of 1908 of the State of Colorado, respectfully represent;

First:- That the undersigned are inhabitants, qualified electors and land owners of the territory hereinafter described and to be embraced in the proposed incorporated Town of Ignacio, map or plat, which territory is now known under the name of Ignacio, and desire to be organized into an incorporated town to be known and designated as the TOWN OF IGNACIO.

Second:- That said proposed incorporated town shall embrace all that land and territory situate and lying in the said County of La Plata and State of Colorado, which is bounded and described as follows, to-wit;


