

Wildlife Damage Management Assistance

The Colorado Department of Agriculture (CDA) has partnered with the US Department of Agriculture's (USDA), Wildlife Services to provide wildlife damage management to assist in reducing predation to livestock.

Predator damage management activities will be provided without cost to livestock producers in Adams, Arapahoe, Broomfield, Boulder, Cheyenne, Denver, Douglas, Elbert, Gilpin, Jefferson, Kit Carson, Larimer, Lincoln, Logan, Morgan, Phillips, Sedgwick, Washington, Weld, and Yuma counties until the annual agreed upon budget has been reached. Efforts will be made to provide services fairly to producers in listed counties.
