

## Colorado RENU Loan Contractor Application Checklist

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Please refer to the following checklist to become an Authorized Contractor in the Colorado Energy Office (CEO) Residential Energy Upgrade (RENU) Loan Contractor Network.

### Required documents

- Completed contractor application and signed participation agreement (5 pages total)
- Proof of commercial liability insurance (CEO must be listed as additional insured)
- Proof of workers' compensation insurance
- State or local professional license (electrician, plumbing, mechanical, etc.)
- Relevant certifications
  - Air sealing / insulation = BPI Building Analyst, Envelope Professional, Air Leakage Control Installer, Energy Auditor, or Quality Control Inspector.
  - PV = NABCEP PV Installation Professional or PV Technical Sales
  - Energy assessment / audit = RESNET or BPI Building Analyst, Envelope Professional, Energy Auditor, or Quality Control Inspector.

### Business requirements

- Good standing with the Colorado Secretary of State
- A listing in the Better Business Bureau (business does not need to be accredited)

### Training

- Attend RENU contractor training
