The Estes Park Housing Authority (EPHA) is a not-for-profit organization committed to providing affording housing to low and moderate-income citizens of the Park R-3 School District. Board members serve in a volunteer capacity for a 5-year term.

Board member responsibilities include active involvement as an advocate for EPHA in the community, assist in retention and development of housing opportunities, and examine policies, procedures and financial reports. The Board is responsible for the employee review of the Executive Director. Board members will be asked to sit on various committees on an as needed. Those committees include financial, personnel, building. Special committee assignments are on an as needed basis.

Board members must reside in the Park R-3 School District. Board meeting is held the second Wednesday of each month at 8:30 a.m., Room 203, Town Municipal Building.
