# INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING AN INDIVIDUAL APPLICATION FOR THE LISTED CONSULTANT PROGRAM

## General Information

- You must be employed by a Listed Consultant Company to apply for an individual consultant number.
- Complete the Listed Consultant Program Individual Form that is available [here](#).

## Minimum Qualifications for Becoming a Listed Environmental Scientist

- At least 5 years of qualifying experience (experience that is pertinent or related to site assessments, remedial investigations, and corrective actions necessary to remediate water or soil contaminated with petroleum), such as:
  - A recognized professional license or certification (e.g., professional engineer/geologist/geological scientist); or
  - A degree from an accredited college/university with at least 30 semester (45 quarter) hours of undergraduate work in engineering; biological, chemical, environmental, or physical science; or industrial hygiene.
- Include a copy of your resume, including dates of work (this is **not** optional) and include one of the following items:
  - Proof of a current PG, PE or equivalent professional certification; or
  - A college transcript that includes at least 30 semester (45 quarter) hours, with a grade of C or better, of relevant coursework (does **not** have to be a sealed transcript).

If you have an Individual Listed Consultant Number that OPS previously issued to you, you do not need to apply for a new number when changing employers. Email your new employer information to Amy Wilson at [amy.wilson@state.co.us](mailto:amy.wilson@state.co.us) so that she may update the database.
