

**NOTICE OF MAIL BALLOT ELECTION FOR
TIMBERLINE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT**

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN and particularly to the electors of the Timberline Fire Protection District of Gilpin and Boulder Counties, Colorado.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a special election of the Timberline Fire Protection District shall be held on Tuesday, November 6, 2018, during the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. The election is being conducted as an independent mail ballot election. The ballots will be mailed to the eligible electors of the District no earlier than 22 days prior to the election (October 15, 2018) and no later than 15 days prior to the election (October 22, 2018).

There shall be one (1) drop off location for the delivery of voted ballots and receipt of replacement ballots which shall be located at the Timberline Fire Station No. 7, 660 Highway 46, Black Hawk, Colorado 80422. This drop off location shall be open from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Thursday, beginning at least 22 days prior to the election (October 15, 2018), and from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on the Friday before the election (November 2, 2018) and from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on the day of the election.

DO NOT RETURN THE TIMBERLINE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT BALLOT TO THE GILPIN COUNTY CLERK OR THE BOULDER COUNTY CLERK. Ballots must be RECEIVED by a Timberline Fire Protection District Election Judge by 7:00 p.m. on Election Day in order for the ballot to be counted. Ballots received after 7:00 p.m. on Election Day will not be counted. Postmarks do not count.

At such election, the eligible electors of the District shall vote for or against the Timberline Fire Protection District Ballot Issue A.
