

## **ATTACHMENT ONE DEFINITIONS**

### **Eligible Training Provider:**

A public or private provider of training services who has submitted an approved application to provide training services under WIA.

### **Program or Training Services:**

- a. One or more courses or classes that, upon successful completion, leads to: (1) A certificate, an associate degree, or baccalaureate degree, or (2) A competency or skill recognized by employers, or
- b. A training program that provides individuals with additional skills or competencies generally recognized by employers.

### **Initial Eligibility:**

To be initially eligible a Training Provider must provide the program information portion of the required information listed in Attachment Two. The performance data for all students should be provided if available, information on WIA students is not required.

### **Subsequent Eligibility:**

After the first full year of eligibility, the Training Provider must supply program information and performance data on the entire student population and on students funded under WIA as listed in Attachment Two.

### **Program Information:**

A description of the program, including certificate, license or degree conferred if applicable, and cost (tuition and fee) information.

### **Unsubsidized Employment:**

Entered full or part time employment not financed by funds provided under the Workforce Investment Act, including entry into the armed forces, entry into employment in a registered apprenticeship program or self employment

### **Program Completer:**

The student met all requirements, conditions and goals of the training program.
