REQUIRED PERFORMANCE DATA

The following information is required on all applications for subsequent eligibility:

- A brief description of the program and all information the Training Provider wants the consumer to review
- The total cost of the program including tuition and fees
- The total number of participants enrolled in the program
- The total number of participants completing the program
- The total number of participants exiting the program
- The total number of participants exiting the program who obtained unsubsidized employment within six (6) months after exiting the program
- The average starting wage of all employed exiters
- The number of WIA participants enrolled in the program
- The number of WIA participants completing the program (not required for programs with fewer than ten participants)
- The number of WIA participants exiting the program (not required for programs with fewer than ten participants)
- The number of WIA completers of the program who obtain unsubsidized employment within six (6) months after program completion (not required for programs with fewer than ten participants)

- The average wage of WIA completers of the program six (6) months after the first day of employment (not required for programs with fewer than ten participants)
- The number of WIA completers of the program who are still employed six (6) months after their first day of employment (not required for programs with fewer than ten participants)
- Where available the number of WIA completers of the program who attain a certificate, degree or license (not required for programs with fewer than ten participants)

DEFINITIONS:

Number of Students enrolled: Total number of people participating in the program at any time during the 12 month period. This should include new enrollees as well as individuals already there.

Number of Students exiting the program: Total number of people who left the program during the twelve month period for any reason (including completers).

Number of Students completing the program: A participant who meets all requirements of the training program. Often this is indicated by some form of certificate or degree.

Number of Students who obtain unsubsidized employment: The number of exiters who earn a wage within 6 months after exiting the program.

Wage at time of placement in job: The average starting wage of all employed exiters (from #4 above).
