

Public Notice

Notice is hereby given of a Public Hearing before the Costilla County Board of Commissioners at 1:00pm on Tuesday February 6, 2018 at the Commissioners' Meeting Room, 352 Main Street, San Luis, CO. The purpose of the hearing will be to take public comment on the Planning Commission's decision to not impose a local medical marijuana plant cap per residence. Colorado House Bill 1220 passed in 2017 and becoming law in 2018 limits all residences to a maximum of 12 plants that can be possessed or grown on a residential property. However, for local jurisdictions that do not have a local plant count limit, the statewide limit of 12 plants can be increased to 24 plants if the medical marijuana patient or caregiver registers with the state licensing authority. HB 1220 does maintain local control. If a local jurisdiction has a plant count ordinance, that law is the ruling authority. If there is no local law, then the new statewide plant count is limited to 12 plants in or on a residential property. The Costilla County Board of Commissioners will take public comment on these issues at the hearing at 1:00pm on Tuesday February 6th.
