

RESOLUTION #05-2015

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF IGNACIO, COLORADO TO ALLOW THE INSTALLATION OF AN UNDERGROUND GREASE INTERCEPTOR WITHIN THE TOWN RIGHT-OF-WAY ABUTTING THE SOUTH SIDE OF PIONEER STREET AND ADJACENT TO THE FARMERS FRESH MARKET BUILDING

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has approved the design and allowed for the construction of the Farmers Fresh Market Building (8/6/2014), and

WHEREAS, the attached Revocable permit (exhibit 'A') is for the purpose of allowing a grease interceptor within the right-of-way on the south side of Pioneer street between Center Alley and Goddard Avenue adjacent to the North wall of Farmers Fresh Market as is shown and described on the attached site plan (exhibit 'B') , and

WHEREAS, the installed grease interceptor is required by the State Health Department and the Town of Ignacio in order to protect the Health, Safety, and Welfare of the Town and its residents, and

WHEREAS, the location and installation will not create an obstruction or reduce the width or usability of the public sidewalk;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF IGNACIO, COLORADO THAT:

- 1) The attached Revocable Permit is approved and the Community Development Coordinator is authorized to sign the permit for the purposes stated in this resolution.
- 2) The Revocable Permit will be automatically revoked if the Board of Trustees determines that area associated for the grease interceptor is needed for public purposes, or if there is any violation of the terms and agreements described in the Revocable Permit (Exhibit 'A').
