Who may ride?

Kiowa County residents and guests of residents. Children under 18 must have a guardian or other adult present.

What is the cost?

See set fee schedule on reverse.
Medicaid is accepted.

Hours of operation?

General Hours:

Monday - Thursday 8:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m.
Fridays by availability. No Holidays.

A 24-hour notice is appreciated to schedule/cancel appointments. If there is no cancellation notice prior to pick up, the rider may be charged a fee. The rider must call the driver and/or Public Health office to cancel.

The Transit will not run during inclement weather; the driver will determine if the trip will be cancelled and will call the rider.

Handicapped Accessible?

Yes. A lift-bus is available for wheelchairs and power chairs.

Medicaid Approved?

Medicaid will pay Medicaid approved medical appointments only. Riders must have an authorization form from the Department of Social Services (generally provided by the Transit driver). This form must be signed by the doctor's office and returned to the Transit driver the day of service.

Helpers?

Helpers for any rider do not need to pay a fee if they are only assisting that rider. It is at the discretion of the Transit driver if a helper is required for clients with special needs or assistance. Transit may provide helpers when available.

Other Trips?

Shopping/Fun trips may be scheduled to Colorado Springs, Pueblo, Lamar, Garden City, and other locations. The base cost of each trip is \$50 for the minivan, \$80 for the big bus, or \$10 per rider, whichever is greater.

Senior Citizen trips may also be scheduled.

Denver trips?

The Transit will accept at least one medical appointment trip to Denver per month on a first come, first served basis. Additional Denver trips will be scheduled as available.
