Notice of Intent to Place Underground Storage Tanks Back into Service

(Revised 12/2013)

Owner/operators shall notify the Director in writing no more than 30 days prior to placing an underground storage tank (UST) back in service, and shall at that same time submit documentation of passing tightness tests, to include ullage, for the tanks and lines conducted within the past 30 days.

Complete this form and return it to the Division of Oil and Public Safety via email, fax or postal mail. If you mail the notice, send it in time to be received at least 30 days, but no more than 60 days, before placing back into service activities begin. Please contact us at 303-318-8506 or 303-318-8505 if you have any questions.

Submit documentation of the Precision (Ullage) Tightness Test on tanks and lines to OPS.
