

Wildlife Control Assistance

The Colorado Department of Agriculture (CDA) has partnered with the United States Department of Agriculture's (USDA), Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service (APHIS), Wildlife Services to provide control of wildlife that have damaged livestock or agricultural products. For this year these wildlife control activities will be provided without cost to agricultural producers in **Adams, Arapahoe, Larimer, Morgan** and **Weld** counties until the annual agreed upon budget has been reached. Efforts will be made to provide services fairly to all five counties according to need.

USDA's Wildlife Services can also provide wildlife control activities in all other areas of the state for a fee.
