

The Colorado Independent Ethics Commission (IEC) seeks applications from local government employees and elected officials – county or municipality – to fill a vacancy on the commission to begin July 1, 2015. A government employee is any employee of local government; a local government official is either elected or appointed.

The appointment of a volunteer commissioner will be for a four year term. Created by Amendment 41, which became Article XXIX of the Colorado Constitution, the IEC issues opinions and rulings related to ethics issues, and hears complaints filed under the provisions of Article XXIX. The Constitution mandates that the commission consist of no more than two commissioners from any political party. Given the affiliation of the current commissioners, the IEC seeks applicants from independent or unaffiliated employees and officials, or third party applicants. All commissioners must have been affiliated with the same party, or unaffiliated, for a period of two years prior to their appointment.
