



- Interviews were conducted to provide insight into and understanding of key stakeholder perspectives of Colorado's current health IT environment.
- The interviews focused on four key subject areas
 - Current State of Health IT in Colorado
 - Expectations and Goals
 - Success Factors
 - Issues / Barriers
- There was general agreement that foundational elements are now in place for health IT to support Colorado's health and health care transformation.

- However, wide disparities in access to, sharing, and use of health information were mentioned.
- There was wide variation of expectations around the Health IT Roadmap and what it would contain.
- There was general agreement on what is required for the Health IT Roadmap to be relevant and used
- Interviewees also identified issues and barriers that are currently inhibiting success.

- There is a clear need for the Health IT Roadmap to align and manage the multitude of health IT efforts and to ensure they are efficiently and effectively contributing to health care transformation in Colorado.
- Is Colorado spending (health IT) money on the right things, in the right way, at the right time?
- What does Colorado need to do ensure that the resources being investing in health IT are being coordinated to ensure optimum outcomes and value for Colorado?
- Who is ultimately responsible for approving the Health IT Roadmap?
- Who is accountable for the Roadmap implementation?

“Our *GOAL* is for Colorado to become the healthiest state in the nation.”


“Our *VISION* is a future where health and well-being are as much a part of Colorado’s way of life as our mountains, clear skies, and pristine environment.”




