ORDINANCE NO. 99

ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING TRAFFIC REGULATIONS ON STATE
HIGHWAY NEWLY CONSTRUCTED, IMPROVED, OR RE-ROUTED

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO STATE HIGHWAYS
PROVIDING FOR CERTAIN TRAFFIC REGULATIONS THEREON; AND
PARTICULARLY RELATING TO STATE HIGHWAY NO. 70 IN THE TOWN
OF ARRIBA, COLORADO;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF
ARRIBA;

SECTION 1. That the public necessity and convenience requires that a portion of State Highway No. 70, which lies in said Town, south of, and adjacent to the Chicago, Rock Island and Pacific Railroad Company Railroad, be reconstructed in accordance with Interstate Standards and plans and specifications of Project No. I 70-5(27) of the State Department of Highways, Division of Highways, State of Colorado.

SECTION 2. Access to the reconstructed State Highway No. 70 will be strictly controlled and will be allowed only at the Arriba Interchange at the intersection of Lincoln County Road 63 and said State Highway 70.

SECTION 3. Upon the basis of engineering and traffic investigations and determinations made by the Division on Highways in behalf of the Town of Arriba it is hereby declared that when standard signs are erected, giving notice thereof, the reasonable and true prima facie speed limit on the portion of State Highway No. 70 through the Town of Arriba and on County Road 63 through

the Arriba Interchange area shall be as specified in the following schedule:

<u>Name of Highway</u>	<u>Portion Affected (Terminal Limits)</u>	<u>Speed Limit</u>
State Highway No. 70	W. Town Limits to East Town Limits	70 MPH
County Highway No. 63	North Town Limits to South Town Limits	35 MPH

SECTION 4. That any violation of this Ordinance shall be punishable in the Lincoln County Court in Hugo, Colorado by penalty provided as follows:

The following penalties, herewith set forth in full, shall apply to this ordinance:

- (a) It is unlawful for any person to violate any of the provisions stated or adopted in this ordinance.
- (b) Every person convicted of a violation of any provision stated or adopted in this ordinance shall be punished by a fine not exceeding three hundred dollars (\$300.00), or by imprisonment not exceeding ninety (90) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

That any Town Marshall of the said TOWN OF ARRIBA is hereby authorized and required to enforce the provisions of the Ordinance and the said Court shall have jurisdiction to hear and try any person charged with its violation and if such person be guilty to punish such person as provided in the above.

SECTION 5. That on any protion of any State Highway connecting link within the said town no person shall violate any of the provisions of Chapter 13, Colorado Revised Statutes, 1963, nor any of the Laws amending the same, or any of the rules or regulations issued pursuant thereto.

SECTION 6. That all traffic and parking regulations hereafter adopted which pertain to the Highways in this Ordinance shall be submitted to the Division of Highways for approval in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 120, Article 13, Section 35(B), Colorado Revised Statutes, 1963, before they shall become effective.

SECTION 7. That if any part or parts of this Ordinance are for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the Ordinance.

SECTION 8. That this Ordinance is necessary to protect and preserve the Public health, safety, convenience and general welfare and shall be in force and effect immediately after passage and final publication.
