

such time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of twenty acres of land.

No. 4—The Green Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 3, which is Four Mile Creek priority No. 1, that Elizabeth L. Green is the owner of said ditch; said ditch draws its water from said Four Mile Creek; that it is used for the irrigation of 33 acres of land belonging to said Elizabeth L. Green and 7 acres belonging to George H. Green, her husband; that its head is located on the east side of said creek at a point in the North East quarter of the North West quarter of Section 23 in Township 18 South Range 70 West, County of Fremont and State of Colorado, from which point the quarter Section corner on the North line of said Section bears North 78 degrees and 25 minutes East, magnetic variation 78 degrees and 25 minutes East, and is distant fifteen and seventy-six hundredths chains; and that there be allowed to flow, continually during the irrigation season, in said ditch for the use and benefit of said owners and under and by virtue of said priority No. 3, one and six tenths (1.6) cubic feet of water per second of time.

No. 5—The Glendale Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities Nos. 4 and 26, same being Beaver Creek priorities Nos. 2 and 12, respectively; that said ditch draws its water from Beaver Creek; that the claimants are Francis Leroux, who owns an undivided two-thirds of said ditch, and John V. Callen, who owns an undivided one-third thereof, and John S. McCurry, who uses water from said ditch under and by virtue of an arrangement with said owners thereof; that said ditch
