

by virtue of said priority No. 5, continuously during the irrigation season, one and six tenths (1.6) cubic feet of water per second of time; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of 40 acres of land belonging to said Pierce.

No. 7—The Porter Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 6; that it takes its water from the Arkansas River; that George H. Toof owns an undivided one-third of said ditch and Ada R. Toof an undivided one-third thereof; that its headgate is located on the South side of said river at a point in Section 22, Tp. 19 S of R. 69 West of the 6th p. m. from whence the joint corners to sections 22, 23, 26 and 27 bears South 30 degrees and 30 minutes East 565 feet; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of forty (40) acres of land belonging to said owners of said ditch; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said owners, under and by virtue of said priority No. 6, continuously during the irrigation season, one and fifty-two thousandths (1.052) cubic feet of water per second of time.

No. 8—The Peggy Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities No's. 7, 67, 151 and 298, which are Beaver Creek priorities No's. 4, 15, 28 and 46, respectively; that the claimants of said ditch are Mrs. Margaret A. Baldridge, who owns two-thirds thereof, and John T. Sullivan, who owns one-third thereof, both interests being undivided; that it draws its supply of water from Beaver Creek; that its headgate is located on the East side of said Creek at a point from which the center of Section 22, Township 18 South Range 68 West bears
