

flow into said ditch, under and by virtue of said priority No. 15, for the use and benefit of said Mills Craig for the irrigation of 28 acres of land, and, also, for the use and benefit of said George H. Green for the irrigation of 3 acres of land, the further quantity of one and and fifty-sixth hundredths (1.56) cubic feet of water per second of time; and that there be further allowed to flow into said ditch, under and by virtue of said priority No. 23, for the use and benefit of said George H. Green, continuously during the irrigation season, thirty-two hundredths (0.32) of one cubic foot of water per second of time; and that there be still further allowed to flow into said ditch, during the irrigating season, for the use and benefit of said George H. Green, under and by virtue of said priority No. 83, the further amount of one and six tenths (1.6) cubic feet of water per second of time. The total amount of water decreed to this ditch is three and sixty-four hundredths (3.64) cubic feet per second of time, and no greater amount shall be allowed to flow in this ditch at any time.

#### No. 12—The Union Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 10; that said ditch draws its water from said Arkansas River; that its headgate is located on the South side of said river at a point North 41 degrees and 28 minutes West fifteen and nine tenths chains (15.9 chains) from the center of Section 7 Township 19 South of Range 69 West; that said ditch is owned by The Union Ditch Company; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of twelve hundred (1200) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch for the use and benefit of the persons entitled thereto, under and by virtue of said priority No. 10, continual-
